1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the impugned orders dated 27.01.2016 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.4, whereby the punishment of reduction to the minimum of the pay scale besides recovery of the loss along with interest in equal proportion from the salary of the petitioners and remaining amount by initiating arbitration/surcharge proceedings has been imposed upon the petitioners and order dated 23.06.2016 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.3 upholding the orders dated 27.01.2016.

2. On 15.02.2023, the following order was passed :-

*“Counsel appearing for respondents No.1 to 3
submits that one of the prayers made in the present writ*



petition was as under :-

“Issue a Writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the Respondent No. 2 to decide the Revision Petition of the petitioners dated 14.07.2016 against the Orders of Respondents No. 3 and 4 as well as issue directions to Respondent No. 3 not to make further recoveries from the salaries of the petitioner, as the impugned Orders amount to doubt jeopardy, in view the Orders dated 01.11.2012 passed by this Hon'ble Court in L.P.A. No.1524 of 2011, titled as “Punjab State Cooperative Supply & Marketing Federation Ltd. Vs. Gurdaspur Pal Singh Bahla”.

And this revision stands decided by the Revisional Authority. Thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Adjourned to 11.10.2023.

Copy of this order be served upon counsel for the petitioners.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action by challenging the order dated 10.08.2021 passed by the Revisional Authority.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
