Instant petition under Section 226 of the Constitution of India has been preferred seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondent No. 7.

2. Heard.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner apprehending threats has moved various representations to respondents No. 1 to 4. He contends that he moved a representation dated 11.05.2023 (Annexure P-6) and further sent a reminder through Registered Post on 12.06.2023 (Annexure P-8) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar- respondent No. 4, but no action had been taken on the said representations till date.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if



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appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 4 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representations in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

- 5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.
- 6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 5 and submits that the aforesaid representations will be considered and dealt with expeditiously in accordance with the law.
- 7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 4-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, to consider the averments made in the representations dated 11.05.2023 (Annexure P-6) and 12.06.2023 (Annexure P-8), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.
- 8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
- 9. Disposed of.
