On 06.02.2024, following order was passed by this Court:

“By way of present petition, challenge was given to the order dated 26.02.2019 (Annexure P-2), whereby learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, declined the prayer of the petitioner to send the complaint to the S.H.O. concerned for getting the FIR registered under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. The revision against this order was dismissed by learned Sessions Judge, Sirsa vide order dated 02.05.2019.

Today, it is stated that after the aforesaid orders, no preliminary evidence has been produced before the Trial Court till date.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner requests for an adjournment submitting that arguing counsel is not available.

Adjourned to 23.04.2024.

Last opportunity.

To be shown in the urgent list.”

It is thus clear that last opportunity had been provided to address the arguments and matter was directed to be put up in urgent list. Despite the same, learned counsel for the petitioner has sent a written request seeking adjournment for two weeks so as to obtain necessary instructions from the petitioner. It is also stated in the written request that opposite counsels were informed telephonically. However, both the opposite counsels appearing for respondent Nos.1 & 2 have categorically stated that they did not get any call from the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the request for adjournment made by counsel for the petitioner is hereby declined.

Having regard to the fact that nobody is making appearance on behalf of the petitioner, present petition is hereby dismissed in default for want of prosecution.
