The applicant-wife has filed the present application for seeking transfer of the petition under Section 24 CPC i.e. HMA/81/2022, titled '*Amanpreet Singh Sekhon v/s Jaspreet Kaur Sekhon* ', filed at the instance of respondent-husband, which is pending in the Family Court, Faridkot, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Bathinda.

In pursuance of the notice issued, respondent had made appearance through counsel.

Learned counsel for the applicant-wife heard.

At this stage, learned counsel for the respondent submits that he has no objection, if the present transfer application is allowed and the petition for judicial separation, filed at the instance of respondent is transferred from Faridkot to the court of competent jurisdiction at Bathinda.



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Considering the submissions, so made by learned counsel for the respondent and also considering the fact about convenience of the wife to be taken into consideration, as per the settled law, without prejudice to the rights of the parties to be adjudicated on merits, the instant transfer application, as such, is hereby accepted and the petition under Section 24 CPC i.e. HMA/81/2022, titled ‘*Amanpreet Singh Sekhon v/s Jaspreet Kaur Sekhon*’, filed at the instance of respondent-husband, stands transferred from the Family Court, Faridkot to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Bathinda. The requisite record of the aforesaid divorce petition shall be transferred by the Family Court, Faridkot to District and Sessions Judge, Bathinda.

Learned District and Sessions Judge, Bathinda, shall assign the said petition to the Family Court, Bathinda. Even, the parties are directed to appear before the Family Court, Bathinda, within a period of one month from today onwards.
