NAMIT KUMAR, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking writ in the nature of *certiorari* for setting aside the order dated 26.04.2018 (Annexure P-6) passed by Respondent No.1. whereby the claim of the petitioner for grant of ACP benefits have been declined.
2. Learned counsel appearing for respondent no.3 submits that the impugned order dated 26.04.2018 has already been set aside and a fresh order dated 20.09.2021 (Annexure R-3/1) has been passed vide which the necessary benefits arising to the tune of Rs.4,15,890/- has already been paid to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the passing of revised order dated 20.09.2021 (Annexure R-3/1), the petitioner is entitled for some consequential benefits, for which he shall submit a justice demand notice upon the respondents within a period of one month from today and the same shall be ordered to be considered in a time bound manner.
4. The prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner has not been opposed by learned counsel(s) for the respondents.
5. If any such justice demand notice is served by the petitioner within a period of one month, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondents by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months thereafter, and in case the petitioner is found entitled to the benefits, the same shall be released within one month from the date of passing of speaking order.
6. All pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
