1. The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for violation of order dated 13.01.2023, passed by this Court in CWP 11179-2022.
2. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order qua which the contempt petition is asserted; has already been complied with and claim of the petitioner has duly been considered by the respondents.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the factual position.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any the grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, she would at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
