1. Petitioners Shakila and Napees have filed present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 to 4 to protect life and liberty of petitioners from the hands of respondents No.5 to 11.
2. It is submitted that both petitioners are major. Copies of their Aadhar Cards are Annexure P-1 and P-2. Petitioners are in live-in relationship and respondent Nos.5 to 11 are unhappy with this relationship. They are receiving threats to their life from the aforesaid respondents. They had also moved representation dated 24.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) to Superintendent of Police, Nuh (Mewat) and Station House Officer, P.S. Ferozepur Jhirka which is not disposed of till date.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of this Court, Mr. Rupinder Singh Jhand, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State. Complete copy of paperbook along with supporting documents is already supplied.



5. Mr. Rakesh Kumar Kachura, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.7 and filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

6. Mr. Azad Khan, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.5, 7, 9 and 11 and filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record subject to just exceptions. He submits that respondent Nos.5, 7, 9 and 11 are not extending any threat to the said petitioners.

7. No purpose would be served by serving notice to remaining respondents.

8. Considering the aforesaid factual position, respondent Nos.2 and 3 are directed to consider representation of petitioners dated 24.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) and protect life and liberty of petitioners from the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 11, considering threat perception, with further direction to maintain their privacy and dignity.

9. The aforesaid protection order will have no bearing on the legality of their relationship and it will not protect them in case there is any violation of law.

10. Petition is accordingly disposed of.

11. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
