Present petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 and not to harass and humiliate the petitioners by way of calling in the police station without issuing any legal notice and further prayer has been made to decide the representation dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) filed by petitioner No.1 at the earliest.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner No.1 has filed a representation dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural), Jagraon but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that petitioners would be satisfied if representation dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) is decided in



a time bound manner.

Heard.

After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural), Jagraon is directed to decide the representation dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioner No.1 expeditiously preferably within one month from today, in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
