1. On oral request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, Sections 325 and 326 IPC are ordered to be added in the head note of the petition. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to make necessary correction in the head note of the petition in the Court itself.
2. The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0065 dated 07.06.2024 registered under Sections 458, 324, 325, 326, 323, 148 and 149 IPC of IPC, at Police Station Nehianwala, District Bathinda.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 02.08.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 02.08.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
