1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.76 dated 07.07.2024, registered under Sections 308, 325, 323, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.
2. By virtue of order dated 30.07.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
4. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner.
5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dharmbir Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
6. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.07.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
