VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to promote the petitioner to the post of Executive Engineer w.e.f. 13.06.2017 with all consequential benefits i.e. the date on which the co-employees of petitioner have been promoted as Executive Engineer on the recommendations of the Departmental Promotion Committee held on 07.06.2017. Other prayers have also been made in the present writ petition.

2. Learned State counsel has placed on record the decision taken on 09.05.2024, which is taken on record and the same has been marked as "Mark A". It is submitted that as per the said decision, it has

been ordered that after mentioning all relevant factors, a self-contained Agenda note be placed before the Departmental Promotion Committee in its meeting to be held in future for consideration of claim of the petitioner to promote him to the post of Executive Engineer.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the same satisfies the claim of the petitioner, at this stage, but prays that the respondent be directed to hold the Departmental Promotion Committee meeting in a time bound manner.

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, at this stage. The respondent-State is directed to hold the Departmental Promotion Committee meeting, in pursuance of the decision taken on 09.05.2024, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.
