For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and copy of air ticket of the petitioner is taken on record as Annexure P-14 subject to all just exceptions.

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1. The petitioner is seeking quashing of arrest warrant orders dated 04.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) and 15.06.2021 (Annexure P-7) issued against the petitioner and order dated 20.09.2021 (Annexure P-12) passed by learned SDJM, Baghapurana, Moga, whereby he was declared a proclaimed person in case FIR No.81 dated 27.12.2018 under Sections 325/341/323/506/148/149 of the IPC registered at Police Station Smalsar, District Moga.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the Trial Court. Learned counsel submits that in compliance of order dated 08.08.2024, the petitioner has placed on record copies of air



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tickets of the petitioner annexed as Annexure P-14 qua his intended travel to India. As per photocopy of the air tickets, the petitioner is due to arrive in India on 06.02.2025 at Indira Gandhi International Airport, Delhi. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Trial Court, and directions be given to the Trial Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. H.S. Deol, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court on or before 13.02.2025. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner. However, this shall be subject to payment of costs of Rs.25,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority concerned, which shall be a condition precedent.

6. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court on or before 13.02.2025, this order shall be of no avail to him, thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail, the Trial Court shall make earnest efforts to decide it expeditiously, in accordance with law.
