1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents/State to grant regular parole to the petitioner for a period of ten weeks.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has moved an application dated 14.06.2024 for grant of parole for some emergency work before the respondent No. 4 but his grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities. He also submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.4 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.
3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of

with a direction to the Superintendent, District Jail, Karnal, respondent No.4 to consider the application dated 14.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of one month from today.
