Learned State counsel submits that in the present petition, the petitioner has sought parole for a period of 10 weeks and in this regard, the petitioner has already given application to respondent No.4 and as per the petitioner, the same is still pending. Learned State counsel further submits that the necessary direction be given to the concerned authority to decide the said application in accordance with law in a given time frame.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a time bound direction is given to the competent authority to consider and decide application having dispatch No.2455-58, dated 20.02.2024 at the earliest.

Learned State counsel submits that the application, if any, filed by the petitioner seeking parole is pending, the same will be decided in accordance with law, at the earliest.
