Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to re-allot the Registration No. "PAI-1" to the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State contends that in view of the provisions of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 and the orders passed thereunder, the old registration numbers cannot be continued and that new series of numbers are mandatorily to be applied for by the registered owners.



In view of the aforesaid statement, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the instant petition at this stage so as to take recourse to his remedy as per law.

The present petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
