SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner is aggrieved by the non provision of Chandigarh quota for Kashmiri Migrants residing in Chandigarh in the Admission Brochure for the academic session 2024-25 to B.Tech Courses in respondent No.1 – PEC, as has been provided for the categories of Sports, Ex-Serviceman and Dependants of Freedom Fighters.

2. Having perused the record and after hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4, on advance copy, it is evident that the petitioner was aware of the fact that there was no quota for Kashmiri Migrants residing in Chandigarh, when the Admission Brochure was issued prior to 01.07.2024, i.e. the date when the



online registration and choice filling process for admission in B.Tech courses commenced in respondent No.1 – PEC.

3. In the matters of this nature, a student should immediately rush to the Court after the issuance of admission brochure.
4. Respondent No.5 has already been allotted subject of Computer Science in B.Tech., which according to learned counsel for the petitioner could have been allotted to the petitioner had the reservation for Kashmiri Migrants residing in Chandigarh been available.
5. This Court is of the considered view that lot many things will have to be upturned, if petitioner’s relief is acceded to and because the petitioner has approached this Court at a belated stage, this Court cannot help the petitioner.
6. Petition, accordingly, stands dismissed.
