1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.56 dated 29.06.2024, registered under Section 420 of IPC, at Police Station Banur, District Patiala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 31.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Reply by way of an affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala has been filed by learned State counsel in Court today and the same is taken on record. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Pal, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 06.08.2024 and is no longer required for further investigation.



4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 31.07.2024, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
