The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab (respondent No.2 herein) to dispose of the appeal bearing ROA No.6 of 2024 titled as "*Harpreet Singh @ Gulshan Versus Commissioner Ferozepur Division, Ferozepur*" expeditiously.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the aforesaid appeal (ROA-6-2024) is pending consideration for 05.08.2024 before the learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab (respondent No.2 herein).

3. Mr. Navneet Singh, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab

appears on behalf of the respondents-State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to him, and submits that in all probability, the appeal (ROA-6-2024) would be decided by the learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab on the next date of hearing, i.e. 05.08.2024, and in any case, within a period of two months thereafter.
