1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 16.07.2001 (Annexure P-3) passed in RSA-1248-2000, the judgment and decree dated 11.08.1995 (Annexure P-1) and the judgment and decree dated 14.12.1999 (Annexure P-2).

2. Written statement filed on behalf of the respondents in the Registry, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.

3. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

4. Counsel for the respondents has submitted that the matter has since been settled between the parties and a distinct portion of the land has already been taken over by the petitioner under the said settlement.

5. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.

6. Dismissed.



7. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
