1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant employment to the petitioner on compassionate grounds.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 21.11.2023, the following order was passed :-

“On 05.01.2022, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Thereafter, vide order dated 23.02.2022, learned counsel for the petitioner sought time to file replication and matter was adjourned to 04.05.2022.

Even on the last date of hearing, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and today also, again the position is same.



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In the interest of justice, adjourned to 23.02.2024.
