The present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to consider and decide the application submitted by the petitioner for allotment of fair price shop/ration depot to him at village Bugra, Tehsil Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Gurpreet Singh Kang, DFSC, Sangrur, submits that the respondent-State has already initiated the process for allotment of fair price shop/ration depot and the applications have been called. She further submits that the petitioner has already submitted an application and that the last date for submission of application by all the interested parties is 22.09.2024. She contends that an appropriate decision, after considering the applications submitted by all the interested parties, in accordance with law shall be taken and that the present petition has been rendered infructuous, at this stage.
