AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Sahil has filed present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for modification of order dated 15.06.2024 passed by Additional Sessions Judge (Vacation Judge), Sonipat to the extent of furnishing original FDR of Rs.2 lakhs either in his name or in the name of surety to the satisfaction of said Court.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner pointed out that petitioner is not financially sound nor he is owner of any property. On the previous date, learned counsel for the petitioner sought adjournment to place on record copy of jamabandi showing the land standing in the name of his deceased father.

3. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner stated that there is no property standing in the name of deceased father of present petitioner. Impugned order dated 15.06.2024 is Annexure P-2 which is passed by learned ASJ (Vacation Judge), Sonipat. However, no application was filed before the said Court to waive off the aforesaid condition which the present

petitioner is unable to satisfy.



4. Learned counsel for petitioner, at this stage, wants to withdraw present petition with liberty to file appropriate application to waive off the condition before the Court concerned.

5. Purpose of furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds is to secure the presence of petitioner/accused for facing trial, as in this case he has already been directed to furnish personal bonds in a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount.

6. In view of this, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file application before the Court concerned for waiving off aforesaid condition to deposit of FDR of Rs.2 lakhs either in his name or in the name of surety. Learned Court will dispose of that application within a period of 10 days.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
