1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking setting aside of the order dated 04.08.2021 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patiala, vide which application filed by the petitioner seeking release of his passport bearing No.P7126980, which was taken into possession by the jurisdictional police authorities in FIR No.33 dated 09.03.2020 under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860

(for short 'IPC') (Section 406 of IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Women, District Patiala, was dismissed.

2. At the very outset, learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Paramjit Singh, submits that the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender vide order dated 24.04.2024.

3. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to file a fresh petition after challenging the order dated 24.04.2024 declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender or file a fresh petition as and when the petitioner submits himself to the process of law by joining the trial.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
