



from the process of law. Learned State counsel for Punjab has also opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. In view of the pendency of several cases against the present petitioner, the petitioner is not entitled to concession of interim regular bail in the present case. Moreover, even as per the medical report (Annexure R-1), the petitioner had only complained of headache, for which he was examined by Neurosurgeon at MAMC, Aghora. It is also apparent that the petitioner is being provided proper treatment from the Medical College and Multispeciality Hospital at Aghora.

5. Thus, finding no merits in the present case and the same is dismissed.

6. Needless to observe that the jail authorities are always under a legal obligation to provide proper medical treatment to every accused as per his health condition.
