[3] Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 06.02.2024 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

[4] Statement of Respondent No.2-complainant namely, Beer Singh @ Raghbir Singh, with regard to compromise was recorded before learned Magistrate on 08.01.2024.

[5] Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

[6] In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R. following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and G.D. No.16, dated 17.02.2019, registered under Sections 324, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar (Rural), and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise qua petitioners, are hereby quashed.
