AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Jaspreet Singh has filed present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking protection of life and personal liberty from the hands of private respondents and to direct respondent No.2 to dispose of representation dated 24.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously.
2. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that on his complaint against Mukul Kumar (respondent No.4) FIR No.20 dated 22.04.2024, was registered at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala (Annexure P-1). Thereafter, respondents No.5 & 6 started harassing him. He also filed representation dated 24.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) but no action was taken.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State. Complete copy of paperbook along with supporting documents is already supplied.

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5. Considering nature of litigation, no purpose would be served by serving notice to private respondents.
6. Petitioner has alleged harassment on account of registration of FIR on his statement against Mukul Kumar respondent No.4 and thereafter he is being harassed and threatened by respondents No.4 to 6. Respondents No.2 and 3 are directed to protect life and liberty of petitioner and to dispose of representation dated 24.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) by passing appropriate orders, considering threat perception.
7. Aforesaid protection order will have no effect on any civil or criminal litigation pending between the parties.
8. Petition is accordingly disposed of.
9. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
