1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents to shift the solid waste dump from existing site at village Wariana to some other distant place and restraining them from setting up solid waste management factory by extending the area of said site and by directing them against dumping any further garbage at the said site, and also for directing them to set up a green belt around the aforesaid solid waste dump site and to ensure that the capping of the existing dump till it is shifted to some other distant place.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.4-MC on instructions from Mr. Mandhir Singh, S.E., MC Jalandhar has submitted that respondent-MC has already initiated action for the redressal of the grievances of the petitioners as prayed in this petition. He submits that tender has already



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been floated and the process of finalizing the tender would be completed in the month of June, 2024. He submits that thereafter, a period of about 26 months would be required for installing the Bio Mining Project. He thus submits that the necessary action as required would be completed expeditiously in accordance with law.

3. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the MC, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.4- Municipal Corporation, Jalandhar to take necessary action for installing the project as submitted before this Court and complete the same in accordance with law within the period as submitted before this Court.

4. The petitioners would be at liberty to pursue their remedy in case any further cause of action accrue to them.
