SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The learned counsel for the petitioner in *CWP No.7080-2015*, as also the counsel for the appellants in *RSA-3223-2012*, submits that he has been instructed to withdraw the petition(supra) as well as the RSA (supra), but subject to directions being passed to the respondents concerned, that as and when a release application is moved before the Collector concerned, wherebefore whom, the compensation amount has been deposited, thereupon the said deposited compensation amount shall be forthwith released to the present petitioner/appellants.



2. The learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by the officer concerned, submits that in case the present petitioner/appellants moves the release application within a period of two weeks from today before the Collector concerned, thereby, the amount of compensation lying deposited, as appertains to the subject lands, shall be forthwith released to the present petitioner as well as to the appellants in RSA bearing No. *RSA-3223-2012*. The said statement is taken on record.

3. In view of the above, the learned counsel for the petitioner in *CWP No.7080-2015*, as also the counsel for the appellants in *RSA-3223-2012* seeks and is granted leave to withdraw both the petitions(supra).

4. It is clarified that on to the said sums of money, all the statutory benefits in terms of the judgement passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court rendered in '*Sunder Vs. Union of India*', *reported in AIR (2001) SC 3516*, shall become added, but only subject to the further condition that if the said statutory benefits do not already became added on to the said sums of compensation amount.

5. All pending application(s), if any, is/are also disposed of accordingly.
