VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 01.09.2020 (Annexure P-10) passed by respondent No.2, whereby the petitioners were directed to vacate the house in dispute.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 has submitted that the matter has been amicably settled and the petitioners are residing with respondent No.4 and thus, submits that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he does not have any instructions regarding the same, but on account of the same, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioners to revive the present case in case any cause survives to them.
