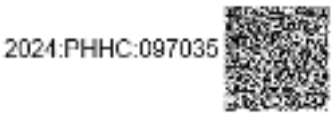

JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondent to count the service rendered as Special Police Officer for qualifying service for the purpose of service benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, *inter alia*, contends that case of the petitioners is squarely covered by judgment dated 12.12.1996 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in ***CWP No. 7451 of 1996*** titled as '***Lal Mohd. and others vs. State of Punjab***' as well as judgment dated 16.03.2023 passed by this Court in ***CWP No. 5648 of 2017*** titled as '***Sukhmander Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others***'.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court submits that in terms of judgments of this Court in ***Lal Mohd.(Supra) and Sukhmander Singh (Supra)***, the respondent



authorities in the case of various officials have considered their claim and passed orders. He further asserts that appropriate authority would consider case of the petitioner in terms of judgment of Division Bench of this Court in *Lal Mohd.(Supra) & Sukhmander Singh (Supra)* and pass an appropriate order within 3 months from today.

4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
