Prayer in the instant application filed under Order 22 Rule 3 CPC is for impleading the LR's of petitioner No.4-Avtar Singh, who unfortunately died on 04.03.2020.

Notice in the application.

Learned counsel for the respondents accepts notice and has no objection to the prayer made in the application.

Consequently, the application is allowed and LR's of petitioner No.4-Avtar Singh, as mentioned in para 2 of the application are allowed to be impleaded as party.

Registry is directed to carry out the necessary correction/modification in the memo of parties.

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1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners for regularization and for grant of all consequential benefits thereof.



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2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the cases of the petitioners for regularization in terms of policy dated 16.05.2023 are under process and shall be finalized within a period of 03 months. He further submits that if the petitioners are found entitled under the said policy, their services shall be regularized.
3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, no further directions are required to be issued in the instant petition and the same is disposed of accordingly at this stage.
4. However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner are found entitled for regularization, the necessary benefits shall be released to them within a period of 02 months from the date of finalization of their claim.
5. Pending application, if any, shall stands disposed of accordingly
