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**NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking the following reliefs :-

*“(i) to count work charge service w.e.f 30.07.1997 to 02.03.2001 (FN), which becomes around 13 years and 7 months approx. along with regular service w.e.f 02.03.2001 (AN) to 31.03.2023, which become around 22 years and 1 month and total service become 35 years & 8 months approx. but the petitioner is granted pension only for regular service of 22 years and to complete/construct the service book of the work charge period on the basis of record/certified copy of service book of work charge period available with the petitioner duly attested by the concerned authority/respondents, which has already being submitted/made available to respondent No.3 by the petitioner.*

*(ii) Further, to grant annual increment which falls due on 01.03.2023, which has not been given/granted to the petitioner, whereas petitioner retired on 31.03.2023.*

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*(iii) Further, to grant interest @ 12% P.A on the delayed payment of pension & other pensionary benefits i.e. arrears of pension, commutation of pension & gratuity etc which were paid after more than 5 months of retirement, as the petitioner stands retired w.e.f 31.03.2023.*

*(iv) Further to grant revised pension & other pensionary benefits accordingly i.e. revised pension, arrears of pension, commutation of pension, gratuity, leave encashment etc. along with the interest @ 12% p.a, in the interest of justice.”*

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the absence period of the petitioner from 01.01.1992 to 31.05.1992 and for 16.06.1992 has been condoned as leave without wages and his case for the release of retiral dues is under process and the same shall be finalized within a period of 04 months and the necessary payments shall be released.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
