ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

The petitioners have prayed for the following substantive relief:

“Civil Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Certiorari thereby quashing the imposition of interest, penalty and compounding the interest and penalty without providing adequate amenities/facilities as per provisions of Haryana Urban Development Authority Act, 1977 and also as per the provisions of Haryana Urban Development (Disposal of Land & Buildings) Act, 1978 and not to take any coercive method for the interest and penalty and also to provide amenities including parking facilities as undertaken by the respondents in front of Booths starting from Booth site Nos.89 to 107, Sector-40, Gurugram, keeping in view the sequel of the facts mentioned below, in the interest of justice.”

Ex facie, a certiorari is prayed for, to quash the imposition of interest, penalty and compounding interest that are sought to be charged by the respondent-authorities. However, after sifting through the paper-book(s), we find that there is no such order vide which the petitioners were required to pay interest, penalty etc.

Upon being pointedly asked, learned counsel for the petitioners concedes that the petition is devoid of any cause of action. Accordingly, he submits that he be permitted to withdraw the petition so as to enable the petitioners to pursue their representation (P-14), the respondent-authorities have been served with.

As prayed, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
