1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to grant the petitioners the pay scale of Rs.2000-3500 w.e.f. 01.01.1986 and revised the same to Rs.2200-4000 w.e.f. 01.03.1991 and thereafter, grant the proficiency

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step-up of Rs.3000-4500 after 8 years of service and second proficiency step-up after completion of 18 years of service in the pay scale of Rs.3700-5300 as being granted to the Junior Engineers under Punjab Government as per letter dated 13.01.1997 issued by the Department of Punjab Government with all consequential benefits such as arrears of pay etc.

2. After arguing the case for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to avail other legal remedies in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
