This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 24.04.2023 passed in CWP-8391-2023.

Learned counsel for the respondents has relied upon the reply filed on behalf of respondent No.5 and has submitted that the respondents have found the petitioner to be entitled for an amount of Rs.22,40,442/- and the same has already been paid to the petitioner. Necessary documents have already been placed on record.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
