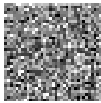

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that husband of the petitioner was working with the respondent No.2-Society and unfortunately died while in service but no service benefits in respect of the services rendered by her late husband have been given to the petitioner, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner has already raised the said grievance by way of submitting a representation dated 15.05.2024 (Annexure P/7), which has been though, addressed to the Chief Minister, Punjab but copy of the same has been sent to all the concerned authorities including the respondent No.2-Society and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is



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issued to respondent No.2-Society to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amar Preet Singh Bains, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 15.05.2024 (Annexure P/7) has been received from the petitioner, the same will be decided by the appropriate authority in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to her otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
