1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing the official respondent Nos. 2 to 6 to conduct proper enquiry regarding the funds spent by the Sarpanch-respondent No.7 without taking permission of the higher authorities.
2. Learned State counsel submits that it has been specifically submitted in the written statement of Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Samalakha filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 6, that proper enquiry has been conducted and in pursuance to the same, recovery is also effected, thus, the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the submissions of learned State counsel as well as paragraph No.2 of the written statement, the present petition may be disposed of having not pressed any further, with liberty to the petitioner to pursue his remedy in case any further cause of action arises.

4. Allowed to do so.
5. The present petition is disposed of as not pressed with liberty to the petitioner as stated above.
