The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking a writ of mandamus, directing respondent No.2, to decide the statutory appeals dated 22/24.07.2024 (Annexures P-4 and P-5) filed by the petitioners, against the punishment order dated 05.09.2023 (Annexure P-3), in a time bound manner. Further prayer has been made to direct respondent No.1, not to effect recovery from the salaries of the petitioners in pursuance to the order dated 05.09.2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for deciding the appeals filed by the petitioners dated 22/24.07.2024 (Annexures P-4 and P-5) expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in a time-bound manner

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, Advocate has put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the appeals filed by the petitioners shall be decided expeditiously.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

Without going into the merits of the case at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the appeals dated 22/24.07.2024 (Annexures P-4 and P-5) pending before the Appellate Authority shall be decided within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
