In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner was working on probation from 26.08.2019 and maximum period of probation has already been completed but no order is being passed by the respondent so as to confirm the petitioner on the post, which is causing prejudice to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that non-confirmation of the petitioner on the post is due to the *mala fide* of the private respondents hence, the respondents be directed to pass an appropriate speaking order on the confirmation of the petitioner on the post in question as he has already cleared the maximum period of probation provided under the Rules.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance of the petitioner has already been raised in the representation dated 26.03.2024, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-11 and the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, if the same is decided by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that, the representation dated 26.03.2024 appended as Annexure P-11 will be decided by the concerned authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned State counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed which will be conveyed to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

Pending application, if any, also stand disposed off.
