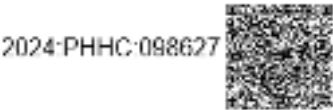
The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of direction to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation and to take appropriate action as per law in FIR No.183 dated 01.12.2022, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1) in the complaint/representation (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 26.04.2024, the following order was passed:-

“The order dated 30.06.2023 (Annexure P-6) passed in pursuance to the directions passed by this Court vide order dated 08.05.2023 (Annexure P-5), is totally cryptic and non-speaking.

Faced with this situation, learned State counsel seeks an adjournment to get instructions.

Adjourned to 02.08.2024.”



Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Gurdeep Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Zira, District Ferozepur, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, which is taken on record.

In the status report, it has been submitted that the petitioner has not attached the complete copy of the speaking order and copy of the same is attached as Annexure R-3, which led to passing of the aforementioned order dated 26.04.2024.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
