At the outset, Mr. Nitin Kant Setia, learned counsel for the respondents-CBSE submitted that the impugned rejection order dated 09.07.2024 (Annexure P-7) is undoubtedly an unreasoned order and submitted that the respondents-Board wishes to take corrective measures by passing a detailed speaking order in accordance with law and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.
