AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioners Kajol Banerji and Gaurav have filed present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 & 5. There is further prayer for issuance of directions to official respondents to decide representation dated 25.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) submitted by petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for petitioners argued that petitioners are facing harassment at the hands of respondents No.4 & 5 on account of business dispute. Respondents No.4 & 5 levelled allegations that petitioners had taken some jewellery but payment was not made. Petitioner No.2 filed bail application due to complaint lodged by respondents No.4 & 5 then it was disclosed that no FIR was registered. Petitioners had given representation dated 25.07.2024 (Annexure P-4) to Superintendent of Police, Jind but no action was taken.

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3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of this Court, Mr. Rupinder Singh Jhand, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State. Complete copy of paperbook along with supporting documents is already supplied.
5. Considering nature of litigation, no purpose would be served by serving notice to private respondents.
6. Considering the facts of case referred above, let life and liberty of petitioners be protected from unnecessary harassment from the hands of respondents No.4 & 5. Respondents No.2 and 3 are also directed to dispose of representation dated 25.07.2024 (Annexure P-4) considering threat perception.
7. Aforesaid protection order will have no effect on any civil or criminal litigation pending between the parties.
8. Petition is accordingly disposed of.
9. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
