Power of Attorney on behalf of the appellants has been filed today in Court by Mr.Nonish Kumar, Advocate, which is taken on the record.

As agreed, as per statements of appellant Nos.1 to 3, learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹5,00,000/- (₹ Five Lakh Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellants in equal shares.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed-cheques in the sum of ₹5,00,000/- in the respective names of the appellants, in equal shares, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 23.02.2024, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The
