The petitioners, by way of present contempt petition, seek initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents, alleging willful disobedience of the order dated 31.01.2020 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No. 13294 of 2015.

[2] Learned State counsel on instructions informs that the services of the petitioners have already been regularized vide office order dated 27.09.2024 and all consequential benefits including the refixation of pay as well as arrears alongwith interest shall be released in favour of the petitioners within a period of four weeks.

[3] In view of aforesaid assurance /undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition any further.
