The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the petitioners benefit of additional honorarium of ₹10,000 per month in view of the notification dated 13.04.2022, Annexure P-2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case they are permitted to make fresh representations before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. R. S. Budhwar, Additional A. G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents, and submits that in case any such representations are filed by the petitioners, the same will be decided by the second respondent expeditiously.



5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file representations before the respondents within a period of two weeks from today. In case any such representations are filed by the petitioners, the same shall be decided by second respondent-Director General, Secondary Education, by passing a speaking order thereupon, within a period of three months of receiving the representations.
