1. This is a batch of six execution second appeals filed to challenge the concurrent orders passed by the Executing Court, which in appeal has been affirmed by the First Appellate Court. These orders were passed while deciding as many as five objection petitions to the Court auction.
2. The learned counsel representing the appellant in all the six appeals state that the matter is rendered infructuous as the auction purchaser has given up his rights in favour of the appellants, who are subsequent purchasers. He submits that a deed of settlement has been placed on the record of the Executing Court, which has now been withdrawn.
3. He has also produced certified copy of the aforesaid deed.
4. The learned counsel representing the respondent has no objection.
5. In view of the aforesaid fact, all the six execution second appeals are dismissed as infructuous.
6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
