HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the benefit which is being claimed by the petitioner in the present writ petition has already been granted to one Sh. Nemi Chand, who has been granted the said benefit after his retirement vide order dated 15.04.2024 and the respondents be also directed to consider the claim of the petitioner in light of the benefit given to Nemi Chand as the petitioner as well as Nemi Chand were selected in the same selection.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioner is basing his case upon the grant of benefit to Nemi Chand and any such representation is filed with the State, due consideration will be given and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation and if it is found feasible to grant the relief as extended to Nemi Chand, the same will be granted to the petitioner

otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file a representation raising the claim on the basis of relief granted to Nemi Chand vide order dated 15.04.2024.

4. Ordered accordingly.
