Learned counsel for the parties agrees that the question of law raised in the present writ petition is covered by the judgment of the Coordinate Bench of this Court in ***CWP No.11049 of 2017 titled as Karamjeet Kaur vs. State of Punjab and another, decided on 06.06.2019*** though the said judgment is pending consideration in Letters Patent Appeal No.1843 of 2019.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the said judgment is under appeal hence, the petitioners should undertake that in case the judgment in ***Karamjeet Kaur's case (supra)*** is any way modified or set aside, the relief being granted to the petitioners on the basis of the said judgment will liable to be withdrawn.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in case, the decision of the Coordinate Bench in ***Karamjeet Kaur's case (supra)*** is modified or the same is set aside by the Division Bench in the LPA No.1843 of 2019, the respondents will have jurisdiction to implement the said decision of the Division Bench upon the petitioners also without even filing the appeal in the present case.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition may be allowed in terms of ***Karamjeet Kaur's case (supra)*** subject to the outcome of the ***LPA No.1843 of 2019 titled as State of Punjab and another vs. Karamjeet Kaur.***
