Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that during the pendency of the present petition, the respondent-College has now passed an order dated 03.04.2023 in which it has been so ordered that as per resolution of the governing body dated 01.04.2023, the suspension period from 13.09.2017 to 28.01.2018 and 28.09.2018 to 30.04.2019 is hereby treated as the duty period and another order dated 06.06.2023 has been passed whereby it has been so ordered that Director has given family pension to the widow of the petitioner. He submitted that in view of the aforesaid orders which have been so supplied to this Court, the present petition has become infructuous.
