By way of present petition filed under Section 482 BNSS,
petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

25	26.03.2024	406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC; 24 of the Emigration Act, 1983	Sudhar, District Ludhiana Rural

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 14.10.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioner may be confirmed.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions received from ASI Karamjit Singh has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and



is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

4. Heard.

5. During the course of hearing on 14.10.2024 the following order was passed:-

“ ASI Kuldeep Singh, Investigating Officer of the case, is present in Court today.

2. Heard.

3. It is, inter alia, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has not received any amount from the complainant and has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that, in fact, co-accused Jasdev Singh was given the payment and the petitioner is not indulging in any travel agency. The investigating officer present in Court, submits that as per the allegations, Rs.1 lakh in cash was paid to the petitioner while Rs.8 lakh was paid to co-accused Jasdev Singh. Admittedly, no amount was paid in the account of the petitioner.

4. List on 06.11.2024.

5. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 14.10.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 14.10.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this

case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
